Would you like to know a secret that has been kept for 6000 years? How about a sacred secret; a secret more important than anything in life?

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## The sacred secret of life:

(In the words of Jesus Christ.)

Mark 4:11-12 *Modern King James Version* – [MKJV] And He [Jesus] said to them, <u>To you it is given to know the [sacred secret, or]</u> mystery of the kingdom of God. But to those outside [those who don't love the truth], all these things are given in parables (12) so that seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and *their* sins should be forgiven them.

Romans 11:25 *Contemporary English Version* (By Paul) – [CEV] "My friends, I don't want you Gentiles to be too proud of yourselves. So <u>I will explain the mystery [or sacred secret]</u> of what has happened to the people of Israel. Some of them have become stubborn, and they will stay like that until the complete number of you Gentiles has come in."

## A revelation of the sacred secret.

Romans 16:25-27 *Modern World Translation* – [MWT] God can make you strong by means of the Good News: The message I tell about Jesus Christ. He can strengthen you by revealing the sacred secret *[or mystery]* that has been kept in silence for a very long time (26) but now is made manifest. The everlasting God ordered that what the prophets wrote must be shown to the people of every nation by means of his son Christ Jesus, to bring them to the obedience that is associated with faith. (27) God alone is wise. Glory belongs to him through Jesus Christ forever! Amen.

We see then, the sacred secret is the explanation Jesus brought to the whole world, after first bringing it to the Jewish Nation. When, though, did this sacred secret originate? The secret was born while our first parents were still in the Garden of Eden. Adam and Eve had sinned against God and brought the forewarned death upon themselves, and on all of us while we were still their unborn children. [Genesis chapters 1-3] (Diseased and dying people cannot give birth to healthy children. In similar fashion, we were born sinful out of Adam and Eve, because they had made themselves sinful. [Psa 51:5; Job 14:4]) When God pronounced judgment on Adam and Eve and Satan, He also promised a

blessing to their unborn children, thus giving birth to the sacred secret: Genesis 3:11-15 *Good News Bible* [GNB] ... God asked. "Did you eat the fruit that I told you not to eat?" (12) The man answered, "The woman you put here with me gave me the fruit, and I ate it." (13) The LORD [קורה] God asked the woman, "Why

They did this to convey they had removed the personal name of the God of the Old Testament (OT) and replaced it with "LORD" in all capitals. They apparently replaced the divine name because of a superstitious fear that developed against pronouncing the divine name. Perhaps also because they felt it difficult to use יהוה in the midst of their English text. Since God had his name (יהוה in Hebrew – it sounds like Yea•Vah to English speakers) recorded over 6000 times in the original OT text, it is clear He wanted his name known. His son Jesus believed that as well. Jesus said to his Father in prayer: John 17:25-26 MWT 25 Righteous Father, the world has, indeed, not come to know you; but I have come to know you, and these [his followers] have come to know that you sent me forth. <sup>26</sup> And I have made your name known to them and will make it **known**, in order that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in union with them." is not to be confused with descriptive titles for God such as "Sovereign Lord," "Creator," "Father," and "the Almighty" or even "God." הוה is the self-given Bible name of the only true God. It was recorded in the original Bible text over 6000 times. You should know God's name! We will use God's Hebrew name, יהוה, when possible. We do so to show respect for God and his own use of his name in the Bible. You should not feel using God's personal name connects you with Judaism. 717 has been the name of the true God for at least all of the 6000 years recounted by the Bible; and Jesus made us all הוה's children. [Gal 3:26-29] Some have attempted to translate the Divine Name into other languages such as the English Jehovah or Yahweh. There is no scriptural instruction or permission to do such a thing!

did you do this?" She replied, "The snake tricked me into eating it." (14) Then the LORD [הוה] God said to the snake, "You will be punished for this; you alone of all the animals must bear this curse: From now on you will crawl on your belly, and you will have to eat dust as long as you live. (15) I will make you and the woman hate each other; her offspring and yours will always be enemies. Her offspring will crush your head, and you will bite her offspring's heel."

The good promise God there uttered (along with his judgment for their disobedience), is that one of the woman's future seed would crush Satan's head. That was and is the foundation of the sacred secret: A seed of the woman who would undo what Satan and Adam and Eve had done to us all. (49) All creation has been waiting to see how that would come about, and who "the seed of the woman" would be, ever since that day. [Rom 8:19-22] Four thousand years later, Jesus Christ presented himself as that "seed" of promise. He thus referred to himself as, and is called in the Bible, "the son of man." [Mat 16:13-17] He came to peel back the lies Satan used to be mirch his Father, and to reveal and teach each of us who הוה really is.2 *The "sacred*" secret," therefore, amounts to the sum total of all the knowledge revealed in and by Jesus Christ. Understanding the sacred secret simply means listening to God's latter day command to be familiar with his son's message. [Mark 9:7] The question for you: Do you actually know what Jesus taught?

You could not (no one could) understand the secret until it was 's<sup>(1)</sup> time for it to be revealed. It is important for you to understand: The time of that revelation has arrived!

Mankind started to appreciate bits and pieces of the secret thousands of years ago – even as God revealed it to them. The ancient Jewish nation was used for a period of time by God both as his representatives in the earth,<sup>3</sup> and to produce the promised "seed of the woman." Mankind knew from a promise made to Abraham about 4000 years ago, that by means of Abraham's seed, all nations of the earth would bless themselves. That prophecy meant the promised Messiah, from <u>Genesis 3:15</u>, would be one of Abraham's descendants.<sup>4</sup> They also knew from God's word that the deliverer would come from King David's line.<sup>5</sup> Just as God's word

the fact that you have listened to my voice."

prophet. (20) My ancestors worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews say Jerusalem is the only place to worship." (21) Jesus said to her: Believe me, the time is coming when you won't worship the Father either on this mountain or in Jerusalem. (22) You Samaritans don't really know the one you worship. But we Jews do know the God we worship, and by using us, God will save the world. (Jesus was born from the Jews as savior to all the world.) <sup>4</sup> Genesis 22:15-18 MWT <sup>15</sup> And تراثر 's angel proceeded to call to Abraham the second time out of the heavens 16 and to say: "By my own name I do swear,' is the utterance of , 'that by reason of the fact that you have done this thing and you have not withheld your son, your only one, <sup>17</sup> I shall surely bless you and I shall surely multiply your seed like the stars of the heavens and like the grains of sand that are on the seashore; and your seed will take possession of the gate of his enemies. 18 And by means of your seed all nations of the earth will certainly bless themselves due to

promised, then, Jesus was born from that Jewish nation and through both Abraham and David.<sup>6</sup> More of the sacred secret was revealed.

A little over 500 years before Jesus was born, mankind knew (again from the Bible) that the revelation of the secret would include the reestablishment of the kingdom of David (an ancient Jewish King who was dear to יהוה's heart, and whose kingdom provided a time of peace for the peoples of the earth who loved God. Please do not confuse this scriptural Christian history with a lesson on or in support of Judaism. When the Jewish religious leaders. and their nation as a whole rejected Jesus as Messiah, he told them their house was abandoned to them.7 The Jews have a favored history as the nation that produced the Christ. When they killed him, however, that arrangement was changed. Since then, Jews have to place faith in Christ Jesus to find favor with הוה; just like the rest of us.8 We must all become a new creation: Those with faith in Christ are reborn by God's spirit [John 3:1-10 plus] from a dying society with a new hope of life. [Mat 17:5 plus] Every person ever born was technically already dead. They just have (or had) a few years to walk around before the death sentence overtakes them. Those who express faith in Christ become a new creation by having been given a gift of life

replacing their death sentence. By means of their faith, they are no longer headed to the grave. They have been made alive by feeding on the words of Christ. [John 6:53 plus] Today, every person alive is either a Christian with a hope of life, or they are not, in which case they will die in their  $\sin^{(40)}$  (if they don't repent and change). That's the only two choices available for any of us! Jesus is the Messiah and the seed of Abraham by means of whom all the earth is (or can be) blessed. All God's promises to all the faithful men and women who have ever lived will be fulfilled through Christ upon all those who adhere to faith in him. (39 - Gal 3:29)) God will restore the peaceful conditions the Jews knew under King David's rule, and far more, under the kingdom of Jesus

Christ.<sup>10</sup> Recognize Jesus as king<sup>11</sup> to the glory of his Father <sup>(1)</sup>.

Luke 19:11 *Good News Bible* [GNB] While the people were listening to this, Jesus continued and told them a parable because he was now almost at Jerusalem, and they supposed that the Kingdom of God was just about to appear.

Mark 11:9-10 MWT The people who were in front and those who followed behind began to shout, "Praise God! God bless him who comes in יהוה"'s name! [Ps 118:26\*aa] (10) God bless the coming kingdom of King David, \*ab our father! Praise be to God in the heights above!"

\*aa [Psalms 118:26 *Literal Version* [LITV] Blessed *is* he who comes in the name of Jehovah; we blessed you from the house of Jehovah.]

\*ab (Luke 1:30-33) 3º So the angel said to her: "Have no fear, Mary, for you have found favor with God; 3¹ and, look! you will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you are to call his name Jesus. 3² This one will be great and will be called Son of the Most High; and Jehovah God will give him the throne of David his father, 3³ and he will rule as king over the house of Jacob forever, and there will be no end of his kingdom."

Psalms 40:5-10 GNB You have done many things for us, O LORD [Jehovah<sup>(1)</sup>] our God; there is no one like you! You have made many wonderful plans for us. I could never speak of them all—their number is so great! (6) You do not want sacrifices and offerings; you do not ask for animals burned whole on the altar or for sacrifices to take away sins. Instead, you have given me ears to hear you, (7) and so I answered, "Here I am to do your will; your instructions for me are in the book of the Law. (8) How I love to do your will, my God! I keep your teaching in my heart." (9) In the assembly of all your people, LORD [Jehovah<sup>(1)</sup>], I told the good news that you save us. You know that I will never stop telling it. (10) I have not kept the news of salvation to myself; I have always spoken of your faithfulness and help. In the assembly of all your people I have not been silent about your loyalty and constant love.

When God's ancient nation was destroyed in 607 BCE (because of the nation's badness) and the remnant held captive in Babylon, God's prophet Daniel realized from Bible prophecy the Jews would be repatriated to their homeland in 537 BCE (after 70 years in captivity, and a little over 2500 years ago). Daniel also believed God would reestablish his kingdom over the earth at that time. Daniel was right in understanding Bible prophecy about the Jews being returned to Jerusalem, but he misunderstood about God's kingdom being reestablished in his day. Daniel's effort allowed mankind to know a little more about the sacred secret, but it still wasn't fully revealed. It was not God's time. When Jesus arrived, he revealed it all.<sup>12</sup> Even so, it took many years for mankind to

Acts 4:8-13 *God's Word* [GW] Then Peter, because he was filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers and leaders of the people, (9) today you are cross-examining us about the good we did for a crippled man. You want to know how he was made well. (10) You and all the people of Israel must understand that this man stands in your presence with a healthy body because of the power of Jesus Christ from Nazareth. You crucified Jesus Christ, but God has brought him back to life. (11) He is the stone that the builders rejected, the stone that has become the cornerstone. (12) No one else can save us. Indeed, we can be saved only by the power of the one named Jesus and not by any other person." (13)

understand what he had said, as Jesus made preparation for his return as king of God's kingdom. [1 Cor 15:28 of 1-34] That brings us to our day in time and to the question: When is Christ's Kingdom revealed?

His disciples asked Jesus that very question: Matthew 24:3 GNB As Jesus sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him in private. "Tell us when all this will be," they asked, "and what will happen to show that it is the time for your [presence, or arrival, or] coming and the end of the age [or system of things, or world]."

They wanted to know when Jesus was going to reestablish God's kingdom over the earth and destroy the old world system. The answer to that question was also the final revelation of the sacred secret of God. Jesus answered them: Matthew 24:5-14 GNB Many men, claiming to speak for me, will come and say, 'I am the Messiah!' and they will fool many people. (6) You are going to hear the noise of battles close by and the news of battles [wars] far away; but do not be troubled. Such things must happen, but they do not mean that the end has come. (7) Countries will fight each other; kingdoms will attack one another. There will be famines and earthquakes everywhere. (8) All these things are like the first pains of childbirth. (9) "Then you will be arrested and handed over to be punished and be put to death. Everyone will hate you because of me. (10) Many will give up their faith at that time; they will betray one another and hate one another. (11) Then many false prophets will appear and fool many people. (12) Such will be the spread of evil that many people's love will grow cold. (13) But whoever holds out to the end will be saved. (14) And this Good News about the Kingdom will be preached through all the world for a witness to all people; and then the end will come.

Note Jesus said the last thing to happen in this dying world system was that everyone would hear the "Good News about the Kingdom." That "Good News" is also the "sacred secret" of God! That sacred secret is what you are now hearing. That apportions it to you and to me to shed light by telling everyone what is

happening to them, and why.<sup>13</sup> Therefore, tell the "Good News about the Kingdom" to everyone who will listen! The more people know, whether or not they choose to become subjects of the kingdom, the closer we are to paradise restored.<sup>14</sup> & (60)

## To summarize the sacred secret, there are four things every person alive needs to know:

First: Everyone needs to understand the importance of the Bible in their life. Knowledge of truth, and faith in it, actually grants your life. <sup>15</sup> An <u>understanding</u> of the knowledge of the sacred secret is available only in the words of Jesus. <sup>(21)</sup> Learning what God is doing my means of Christ's teachings helps us know הוה (1) and to desire his will. We can then have faith we will receive what we seek because it is in harmony with the will of God.

**Second:** As Jesus was quoted above, (Mat 24:14) the end of this old system cannot come until the preaching work is completed. That work is accomplished as sincere students of Jesus Christ speak lovingly with others about what they have learned *from the Bible:* About the sacred secret of "the good news of the kingdom." There is no reason to fight with anyone. As you speak wholeheartedly about your Bible hope, being careful to direct them only to the words of Christ, whether they hear or not, you strengthen your own faith by your effort. If they don't want to hear, take your leave. [Mat 10:12-14] The choice is theirs alone. Maybe they will hear

thousand, and the small one a mighty nation. I myself, הוה, shall speed it up in its own time." [איהוה will likely "speed it up" by making known his sacred secret. You can help!]

15 John 17:1-4 GNB After Jesus finished saying this, he looked up to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come. Give glory to your Son, so that the Son may give glory to you. (2) For you gave him authority over all people, so that he might give eternal life to all those you gave him. (3) And eternal life means to know you, the only true God, and to know Jesus Christ, whom you sent. (4) I have shown your glory on earth; I have finished the work you gave me to do.

from you what Jesus said and express faith later. By your obedience, you work out your own salvation.¹6 (That is not to say you can earn life. Life is a gift from our heavenly Father to those who choose to stop harming other people. If you love Jesus [and other humans], however, you will obey him.<sup>(63)</sup>)

Third: Jesus was quoted as saying in Mat. 24:5 (above), that many would claim to be teaching what he taught when they really weren't. Jesus said all those false teachers would comprise a composite force of apostasy he and his followers referred to as "the man of lawlessness."17 They also said that man of lawlessness would have to be "revealed." His needing to be revealed implies he exists in secret and has achieved some stature in appearing upright and holy. He (being all the false religious teachers combined) needed to be revealed because he was claiming (each component sectarian part of him was claiming) he was a Christian teacher, while he was not. Jesus warned his true followers not to be misled by religion. The danger of being misled was real even for Jesus's own footstep followers. That danger is real for each of us as well. Jesus taught you how to both recognize and to help expose the man of lawlessness! Very simply, every sect of the "man of lawlessness" shares one thing in common: They are all following the doctrines of men instead of Jesus's teachings. Just think: Do they direct you to read the words of Jesus Christ from the Gospels for your-own-self, or to read their organization's literature and doctrinal materials? Simple!

**Fourth:** Perhaps most importantly, everyone needs to understand: "The end" Jesus spoke about is not a bad thing. It is

the end of this old world system which has existed for all these thousands of years since Adam. That old system has existed apart from God's direction. The actions by all those unrighteous rulerships, and those who create and follow them, are the manifestations of mankind's disobedience to God. That rebellious course has created the great tribulation consuming our world in these last days. That's what Jesus was talking about in <a href="Mat 24:6-12">Mat 24:6-12</a> (above). Every single thing he mentioned prophetically as the composite sign of the end of this system is coming true in our day!

There will be lots of people who think these four points, along with this very specific warning by Jesus Christ, are foolishness.<sup>18</sup> Don't

(26) For you see your calling, brothers [and sisters], that [there are] not many wise according to [the] flesh, not many powerful, not many noble [or, of high social status]; (27) but God chose the foolish [things] of the world, so that He should be humiliating the wise; and God chose the weak [things] of the world, so that He should be humiliating the strong; (28) and God chose the insignificant [things] of the world and the [things] having been despised [or. looked down on], and the [things] not being, so that He should nullify the [things] being [fig., which exist], (29) in order that all flesh shall not [or, no flesh shall] boast before God. (30) But by Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God,

you see, though, that is the very decision we are *all* making?(19) That is what Jesus came to cause to happen. [Mat 10:32-37] We are each and every one of us judging ourselves by our reaction to what Jesus came to tell. 19 Some individuals have been saving "he is coming, he is coming," nearly since the sacred secret was first uttered 6000 years ago in the Garden. (38) Make no mistake; it will happen. What should be of great interest to each of us: It is likely happening in our day. If you choose to ignore what Jesus Christ taught, you will lose your life. (40) If you do build faith in him, it is vour source and method of eternal life. (15) If you are to have such faith, you must start with gaining a personal understanding of what Jesus Christ taught. Therein lies a great danger for you. Jesus said in Mat. 24:5 (above) that many would claim to be speaking for him when they really were not. Based on that warning, we now reveal the clear distinction between "religion" and "Christianity." You can recognize Christianity as the only true faith because everything Jesus Christ said would happen, is happening. True Christians define themselves as his followers by discerning and following only his teachings.<sup>20</sup> Any form of worship

that isn't Christianity can be referred to as religion. From that warning Jesus gave in John 10:22-28, we can know something else about religion: Even those forms of worship that claim to be Christian must be tested to see if they really are. [Mat 7:21-23] How can you test? Simple! By knowing for yourself what Jesus taught.(20) If you know what he actually said, you will know whether those who come in his name are really speaking his words. You must "remain in his teachings."21 What does that mean, really, to remain in the teachings of Jesus. That hasn't changed one bit since he was alive on earth. When his mother and brothers came to speak with him while he was telling others what his Father sent him to teach, (37) they sent someone in to interrupt him to tell him his family was outside wanting to speak with him. He told that person to look around at those sitting at his feet, listening to what he said, and then told him: (Mark 3:31-35) 31 Now his mother and his brothers came, and, as they were standing on the outside, they sent in to him to call him, 32 As it was, a crowd was sitting around him, so they said to him: "Look! Your mother and your brothers outside are seeking you." 33 But in reply he said to them: "Who are my mother and my brothers?" 34 And having looked about upon those sitting around him in a circle, he said: "See, my mother and my brothers! 35 Whoever does the will of God, this one is my brother and sister and mother." According to Jesus, those who were sitting at his feet to learn from him were the ones doing the will of his Father.<sup>22</sup> That made them

his family. If you do the same (and you are careful to follow only Jesus's teachings) you will be preserved alive. Your faith in truth will grant you life.<sup>23 & (42)</sup> In light of Jesus's warning about false teachers, it is wise to consider the ways he said we can identify them. He said we could know the false teachers by the fruit they bear.<sup>24</sup> As Jesus said, whether they are producing good fruitage is seen in whether they are learning (and teaching) what he taught. If people want to join you in reading what Jesus taught, right from the Bible, that is good fruit. If they want to involve you in a study of materials written by their organization (which they will likely call Bible study aids), you are in danger. Jesus was sent to teach us what his Father wanted us to know.<sup>25</sup> Those men who want to convince you of your need for them to explain what Jesus meant are really trying to replace him as your teacher. They are in effect

saying they are Christ (or his replacements). (38) If you can be convinced by men that you need them to explain what Jesus meant, who are you really following? Jesus said exactly what he wanted you to know. It's a very simple process really: יהוה is looking through the earth for righteously inclined individuals who are looking for him.<sup>26</sup> God then directs those persons (those with a heart complete toward him) to the teachings of his son.<sup>27</sup> Jesus, in turn, teaches those who are drawn to him by his Father's Spirit, about his Father.<sup>28</sup> What you need to know is contained in the record of Jesus's teachings in the four short Bible books of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.<sup>29</sup> Sitting at Jesus feet, by reading his own words, puts you in the group he founded and said were his family. (22) That is the sacred **secret of God!** Be very cautious of joining any religious group, or in feeling justified in your membership among such groups.<sup>30</sup>

knowledge of what he taught.<sup>36</sup> Jesus also came to warn about false teachers, and to reassure you that you don't have to be deceived by them. Jesus is right there in our own Bible; [Heb 4:11-12] we all simply need to listen to what God sent his son to teach.<sup>37</sup> & <sup>38</sup> We can be sure we are really listening to Jesus only by reading his words for ourselves. (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.) By doing so, we demonstrate we are adopted into Jesus's family and become sons and daughters of his Father. (22) We put ourselves in line for the blessings promised to the seed of Abraham.<sup>39</sup> If religious people really do mean well, they will

If you will survive the end of this old system,<sup>41</sup> you must build faith to preserve yourself alive.<sup>42</sup> What הוה is doing by means of his son Christ Jesus must be real to you. It must be real every second of every day. You must realize Jesus is right now "subduing in the midst of his enemies."(43) Satan still influences this old world system, [1 John 5:18-21] but the teachings of Jesus have raised an army of Christians amongst the world's followers of Satan, who are each one submissive and loyal subjects of the kingdom of Christ.<sup>43</sup>

The truth they share with this world is burning away the facade of decency that allows 1/4<sup>th</sup> of the world's population to starve while others preach to them from glass cathedrals and ivory towers.44 The common message among false Christian sects is that salvation equates with membership in their respective group, and they will be blessed for giving money. When men claim your salvation is tied to approval by their group, what they are really saying is "here is the Christ or there." When they assert you can't understand the Bible apart from their interpretation, they are claiming they are the Christ, or his God appointed stand-ins. Don't be fooled! (38) (After Jesus left, there were men appointed by holy spirit to govern the first century congregations<sup>45</sup> (so as to give Christianity a start in the midst of religious people who wanted to destroy it). Such spirit appointed men, acting for Christ, could also raise the dead and heal the sick; just like Jesus could. The Bible says such gifts would die out, replaced by the revelation of the sacred secret.<sup>46</sup> In our day, Christians live by faith in the recorded words

process of repairing all the damage Satan has done.<sup>49</sup> People just need to be directed to what Jesus said so they can understand that fact. It is a very bad thing to assure people their help will come through an approved standing with some group of men. What they (or any of us) can do, and should do, is speak the truth to others by directing them to what Jesus taught. Our doing so gives them a chance to build faith in *Christ*. Contrary to popular belief, you can not have a true and lasting faith<sup>50</sup> in Jesus Christ if you don't first know what he said. Reading your Bible is the only method by which you come to know him. We do, of course, need to show loving kindness toward other people, helping them as we are able. Remember, however, Jesus is God's empowered king and is in the process of fixing everything that is wrong. Remember too, our faith in that solution is the personal deliverance for each one of us.51 Do some real good: Help others have faith in what Jesus taught.

You have faced and will face trials in this old world system. If this system was good, God would not be in the process of replacing it. It is crumbling down on itself. God wants to protect you alive, but you must become a person He can depend on if He is to be able to help you. If He didn't make it so, those He protected would put us all right back in the same mess; by again choosing to disobey our Creator. What that means is we must be determined, no matter what, to follow the directions of the son God sent to teach us.<sup>52</sup> We

(34) When the time came to gather the grapes, he sent his slaves to the tenants to receive his share of the harvest. (35) The tenants grabbed his slaves, beat one, killed another, and stoned another. (36) Again the man sent other slaves, more than the first time, and the tenants treated them the same way. (37) Last of all he

must become persons determined to do what God says because we know God always does what is absolutely best for everyone. That's what Jesus teaches us by his example. [11] If the promises of God aren't the most important thing in your life, the trials you face may overwhelm you. Those you love may turn their back on you. You may find that what you have hoped in, or the people you believed in, are not who they pretended or who you believed they were. If the kingdom by Christ is real to you, you will surely read and meditate on *his teachings* as the most important part of your life. In that case, none of those trials will really matter; because your love for God is most important. 53 You will know his promises are good and that your future is bright!

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Philippians 3:4-10 GNB I could, of course, put my trust in such things. If any of you think you can trust in external ceremonies, I have even more reason to feel that way. (5) I was circumcised when I was a week old. I am an Israelite by birth, of the tribe of Benjamin, a pure-blooded Hebrew. As far as keeping the Jewish Law is concerned, I was a Pharisee, (6) and I was so zealous that I persecuted the church. [Before Paul's conversion to Christianity, he persecuted the followers of Jesus as a religious leader of the Jewish nation.] As far as a person can be righteous by obeying the commands of the Law, I was without fault. (7) But all those things that I might count as profit I now reckon as loss for Christ's sake. (8) Not only those things; I reckon everything as complete loss for the sake of what is so much more valuable, the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have thrown everything away; I consider it all as mere garbage, so that I may gain Christ (9) and be completely united with him. I no longer have a righteousness of my own, the kind that is gained by obeying the Law. I now have

sent his son to them. 'Surely they will respect my son,' he said. (38) But when the tenants saw the son, they said to themselves, 'This is the owner's son. Come on, let's kill him, and we will get his property!' (39) So they grabbed him, threw him out of the vineyard, and killed him. (40) "Now, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?" Jesus asked. (41) "He will certainly kill those evil men," they answered, "and rent the vineyard out to other tenants, who will give him his share of the harvest at the right time."

The teachings of Jesus must be so real that you consider yourself part of his family. More importantly, he must consider you part of his family. When he was instructing others about what he learned from his Father, his family approached requesting he come outside and speak with him: (Mark 3:31-35) 31 Now his mother and his brothers came, and, as they were standing on the outside, they sent in to him to call him. 32 As it was, a crowd was sitting around him, so they said to him: "Look! Your mother and your brothers outside are seeking you." 33 But in reply he said to them: "Who are my mother and my brothers?" 34 And having looked about upon those sitting around him in a circle, he said: "See, my mother and my brothers! 35 Whoever does the will of God, this one is my brother and sister and mother." While this material was previously considered, it is mentioned again so you will take special note of who Jesus considered to be his family: Those who were are "doing the will of his Father." Jesus noted those who were doing his Father's will, were the individuals seated around him listening to what his Father wanted them to know.(37) That's how you make yourself part of Jesus's family right down to this day. Read what Jesus came to teach you in Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. (29) It really is just that simple.(2)

We have spoken several times about surviving the end of this old system (or being preserved alive). It is important to realize that wonderful hope is part of the sacred secret of God. God promised (in the book of Job) there would come a time when there would be someone to intervene in behalf of those heading to the grave, and would turn them back from it. He promised their flesh would grow young again.<sup>54</sup> Jesus mentioned that hope as well. Just before he

resurrected Lazarus, Jesus told Lazarus's sister Martha all those who had died would be resurrected, but those who were alive at the time of his return (to do the resurrection) would never die at all.<sup>55</sup> Jesus also said the end of this old system would be like the days of Noah and Lot. Both were men of faith, and they (along with all who would listen to them) were preserved alive in their respective days of destruction (and of salvation).<sup>(41)</sup> When each of those men lived, the earth (or the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah in Lot's case) was filled with violence.<sup>56</sup> Just as Jesus said, the destruction of the earth in our day will be similar to the days of Noah. The righteous will be preserved alive while the wicked will

to go to the world of the dead. (23) Perhaps an angel may come to their aid--- one of God's thousands of angels, who remind us of our duty. (24) In mercy the angel will say, "Release them! They are not to go down to the world of the dead. Here is the ransom to set them free." (25) Their bodies will grow young and strong again; (26) when they pray, God will answer; they will worship God with joy: God will set things right for them again. (27) Each one will say in public, "I have sinned. I have not done right, but God spared me. (28) He kept me from going to the world of the dead, and I am still alive." (29) God does all this again and again; (30) each one saves a person's life, and gives him the joy of living. <sup>55</sup> John 11:21-27 GW Martha told Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. (22) But even now I know that God will give you whatever you ask him." (23) Jesus told Martha, "Your brother will come back to life." (24) Martha answered Jesus, "I know that he'll come back to life on the last day, when everyone will [be resurrected] come back to life." (25) Jesus said to her, "I am the one who brings people back to life, and I am life itself. Those who believe in me will live [be resurrected] even if they die. (26) Everyone who lives [at the time of his return] and believes in me will never die. Do you believe that?" (27) Martha said to him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who was expected to come into the world."

be destroyed. As God promised Ezekiel, when the wicked are destroyed, those marked in their forehead (because they were sighing and groaning over the badness in the earth) will be preserved alive.<sup>57</sup> Your personal faith in Christ Jesus is the mark in your forehead. God foreknew a great tribulation that Jesus warned us about. He could know it would happen because it is the natural consequence of disobedience to him. He did not cause it or bring it. We brought it upon ourselves by our having destroyed and polluted the earth the way we have. God actually holds off the destruction<sup>58</sup> until just the right time so as to save as many as

possible. When God releases the destruction of our own making, He will at the same time be protecting those who love him through their faith in his son (those who are marked in their forehead). That destruction may already have been released. If not, very soon. Everyone is deciding for themselves if they will exercise faith in Christ!<sup>59</sup> The tribulation we have brought, and are witnessing, will drive everyone to examine the hope that is wrapped up in Jesus – the sacred secret. We will all build (or we are building) faith in Jesus, or we won't. There is no exemption from the war. You must decide you do love God, or, it means you don't. Read what Jesus taught and warn others to do the same. It is our only hope!<sup>60</sup>

If you wrap yourself in the teachings of Jesus Christ and try to follow his example, you don't really have to worry about what not to do. His example will always help you know. With so many false teachers about, however, it seems wise to give what we should not do some consideration.

The apostle Paul said: Colossians 3:5-17 GNB You must put to death, then, the earthly desires at work in you, such as sexual immorality, indecency, lust, evil passions, and greed (for greed is a form of idolatry). (6) Because of such things God's anger will come upon those who do not obey him. (7) At one time you yourselves used to live according to such desires, when your life was dominated by them. (8) But now you must get rid of all these things: anger, passion, and hateful feelings. No insults or obscene talk must ever come from your lips. (9) Do not lie to one another, for you have put off the old self with its habits (10) and have put on the new self. This is the new being which God, its Creator, is

Isaiah 11:1-10 American Standard Version [ASV] And there shall come forth a shoot out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots shall bear fruit. constantly renewing in his own image, in order to bring you to a full knowledge of himself. (11) As a result, there is no longer any distinction between Gentiles and Jews, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarians, savages, slaves, and free, but Christ is all, Christ is in all. (12) You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. (13) Be tolerant with one another and forgive one another whenever any of you has a complaint against someone else. You must forgive one another just as the Lord has forgiven you. (14) And to all these qualities add love, which binds all things together in perfect unity. (15) The peace that Christ gives is to guide you in the decisions you make; for it is to this peace that God has called you together in the one body. And be thankful. (16) Christ's message in all its richness must live in your hearts. Teach and instruct one another with all wisdom. Sing psalms, hymns, and sacred songs; sing to God with thanksgiving in your hearts. (17) Everything you do or say, then, should be done in the name of the Lord Jesus, as you give thanks through him to God the Father.

We have all practiced some of these wicked things, and we all struggle against the desire to practice some of them still yet. Otherwise, we would be perfect.<sup>61</sup> (We will, of course, regain perfection when we are in paradise, and those sinful desires will be gone forever.) The point for us to realize is this; we must be *trying*

to follow Christ, which also means we fight against our sinful desires condemned by God. If we fall down, we must get up and renew the fight. We don't willfully practice such sins, or ever say they are alright for others to practice, maybe by asserting our tolerance of badness is an expression of love. We must love God before we can love anyone else. Et all we really do love God, we will obey him. Sometimes people look for their guidance to what the law of the land says is acceptable. Don't be fooled: If you practice or condone as acceptable what God condemns, you are not a follower of Jesus Christ. If you are able to get every person alive to say you are right to practice a thing God condemns, you are still wrong. You don't have to argue with people who pronounce that what is bad is good, or be concerned with their lifestyle. Just tell

No one who is immoral or worships idols or is unfaithful in marriage or is a pervert or behaves like a homosexual (10) will share in God's kingdom. Neither will any thief or greedy person or drunkard or anyone who curses and cheats others. (11) Some of you used to be like that. But now the name of our Lord Jesus Christ and the power of God's Spirit have washed you and made you holy and acceptable to God. (12) Some of you say, "We can do anything we want to." But I tell you that not everything is good for us. So I refuse to let anything have power over me. 65 Isaiah 5:18-24 MWT How horrible it will be for those who string people along with lies and empty promises, whose lives are sinful. (19) They say [insincerely], "Let God hurry and quickly do his work so that we may see what he has in mind. Let the plan of the Holy One of Israel happen quickly so that we may understand what he is doing." (20) How horrible it will be for those who call evil good and good evil, who turn darkness into **light and light into darkness**, who turn what is bitter into something sweet and what is sweet into something bitter. (21) How horrible it will be for those who think they are wise and consider themselves to be clever. (22) How horrible it will be for those who are heroes at drinking wine, who are champions at
